

Calculating your Grade Point Average*

GPA can be computed by taking your *Total Quality Points* (semester or cumulative) and dividing it by the sum of your *Total Earned Hours* (semester or cumulative).

$$\text{OR GPA} = \frac{\text{Total Quality Points}}{\text{Total Earned Hours}}$$

To calculate your GPA:

- 1) Write in the 'Courses' you took.
- 2) Write in the 'Grade' you expect to receive for that class.
- 3) Write in the 'Number Value' for that grade (A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0).
- 4) Write in the 'Credit Hours' you will receive for that course.
- 5) Multiply the 'Number Value' by the 'Credit Hours' (Quality Points = Number Value x Credit Hours).

--Do this for each course you take--

- 6) Add up the total 'Credit Hours'
- 7) Add up the total 'Quality Points'

To calculate your SEMESTER GPA:

Semester Quality Points Total (7) _____
 DIVIDED BY Semester Credit Hours (6) _____
 EQUALS your semester GPA _____

To calculate your CUMULATIVE GPA:

Add (7) to all of your previously earned Quality Points _____
 DIVIDED BY the sum of all your previously earned Credit Hours including (6) _____
 EQUALS your Cumulative GPA _____
