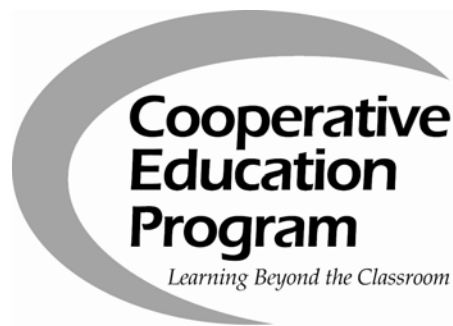


Why Co-op?
