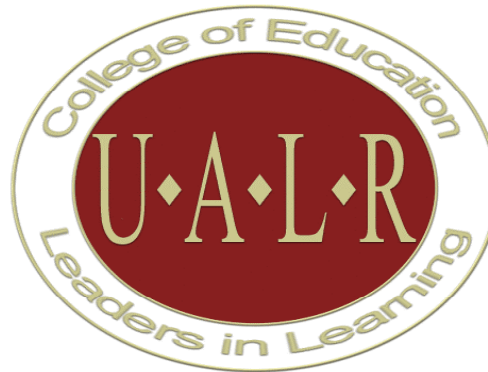

- **Then, we will have focus groups according to program areas so that individual programs can collect specific feedback for improving their programs.**



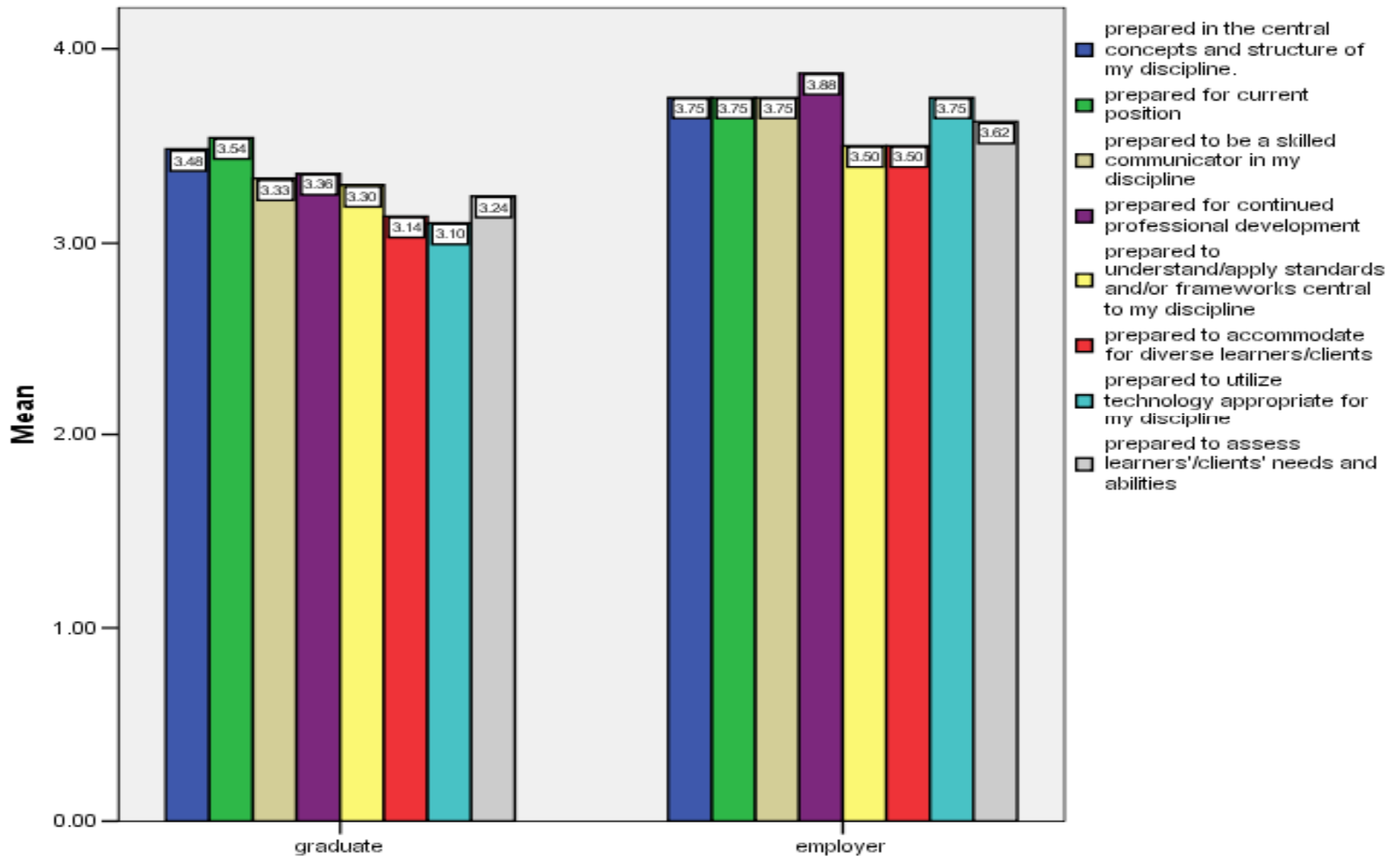
**Graduates' and

- **Employers rate the graduates' program-related outcomes somewhat higher than the graduates rate these outcomes.**
