## *Famous International Sites*

*by the Foundations level*

### **South Korea**

#### ***Busan*** by Young-Su Park

Busan is Korea's second largest city with a population of 4 million. Busan is a trade port located on the southeast end of the Korean Peninsula. Therefore, there are many tourist sites related to the sea. Also many foreigners visit Busan due to the Busan International Film Festival, which is becoming an internationally recognized film festival. Haeundae Beach is probably the most famous beach in the Busan. The name "Haeundae" was named by scholar Choi Chi-Won (857-?) of the Silla Dynasty (BC57- AD 935). When he was walking past Dongbaekdo Island, he was fascinated by it and left carved words "Hae Un Dae" on a Stone Wall on Dongbaekdo Island. Haeundae is 1.5 km long, 30-50m wide, with an area of 58,400m. The white sand is rough and easily sticks to your skin. The sand of this beach is composed of sand that come from Chuncheon Stream and shells that have disintegrated naturally by the wind over a long time. Haeundae Beach is also famous for the various cultural events and festivals held throughout the year. At Haeundae there is a Folk Square where you can enjoy traditional games such as

Neoldduigi (seesaw jumping), Korean wrestling, Tuho (arrow jumping). Tug-of-War and yutnori. There is also the Beach Culture Center and the Beach Library. Numerous people visit every year from June to August.

### ***Korean Folk Village*** by Jung Man

The Korean Folk Village reproduces the lifestyle of the Chosun dynasty. In the village, there are common people's houses from different parts of the country, an oriental medicine building, buildings for the study of Chinese characters, a blacksmith's building, a handicraft room, a pottery oven and a marketplace. You'll also find a mansion which has 99 rooms, reflecting the luxurious life style of the yangban(aristocrat) class, and a government office. At the market, Korean traditional food and green onion pancakes and Korean alcoholic beverages are sold.

Location : Gi heung-Eup, Yong in-Si, Kyung gi-Do, South Korea.

Transportation : Take a Folk Village Suttle bus at Suwon subway Station or KNR line. If you were abroad, you could call 82-2-1330

### ***Bulguksa Temple*** by Young Hoon

Bulguksa Temple, built with a combination of stylish architecture, Buddhist spirit and natural surroundings, symbolizes Buddha's land on earth.

The stone layers harmonize perfectly with the different structures, such as the several halls and the statues of Buddha within them.

Bulguksa Temple was built in the 10th year of King

Gyeongdeok, 751 A.D. by Kim Dae-seong, in memory of his parents. It was restored to its original condition in 1973.

It was designated as the UNESCO Cultural Heritage on December 6, 1995.

### ***Chonhwadae of Seoraksan*** by Linda Jung

After being designated as natural monument No. 171 in November 1965, Seoraksan became the 5th national park in March 1970. It was selected as a conservation area, the only one in Korea, by UNESCO in 1982, because of its variety of plants and animals. Since then, the movement to protect Seoraksan gained momentum. Seoraksan can be divided into three parts: Outer-Seorak, Inner-Seorak, and South-Seorak. Outer-Seorak encompasses part of Sokcho City, which held the "1999 Kangwon International Tourism Expo" and has beaches, spas, and wonderful lodging and leisure facilities. The inner part of the Taebaek Mountain Range is named Inner-Seorak and has many famous temples, including Baekdamsa and Bongjongam, (Garibong valley) and also has the Suryom-dong valley which is known for its crystal-clear water. The area situated at south of the main ridgeline of Seoraksan is called South-Seorak. South-Seorak includes Osaek Fresh Water Spring and carbonic acid spas.

South-Seorak is a popular starting point for hikers, since it has the most direct route to Daechongbong, the main peak of Seoraksan.

### **Taiwan**

#### ***Lan-Yu Island*** by Joyce Wang

Lan-Yu Island is located Taiwan's Eastern and Southern in the Pacific Ocean. The measure of the area is just 45 km<sup>2</sup>. It belongs to a volcano island. There are almost hills in Lan-Yu and it also call "Red Head Island". Lan-Yu Island grows orchards abundantly. If you want to go there, your transportation will be airplane and ferry.

The fly fish follow from Japan Current to come to Lan-Yu Island in March to July every year. So, fly fish bring business to this island.

The domestic animals put out to pasture. So, you can

see mini pigs “smell and walk” and goats relax in a cool place everywhere.

There is a tribe, we call them “Ya-Mei clan”. They still have traditional character, culture and customs of the area. Ya-Mei clan is only about 3 000 people. They are the last in all the tribes.

Lan-Yu Island’s climate belongs to tropics, high temperature and a lot of rain. The corals surround all island. The weather is changing constantly. So, Lan-Yu Island has abundant plants and animals. Lan-Yu Island became animals’ home.
