## **2010 FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP**

Altrusa International, Inc. is a builder of women. Its objectives include being of service to both young and mature women already engaged in or entering business or professional fields and promoting educational and cultural training and improvement.

Altrusa International, Inc. of Little Rock, Arkansas, U.S.A. Foundation (the “Foundation”), a charitable corporation established in 1992, announces the availability of one or more scholarships to be awarded to students who are considered to be “non-traditional” due to age or entry into a field of study after delayed high school graduation or the award of a Graduate Educational Degree certificate or the presence of other personal circumstances, including being a single parent.

Scholarship awards will be \$500 each per year and will be chosen in January 2010. Payment will be made directly to the educational institution toward tuition, fees or expenses such as books and materials upon receipt of an invoice from that institution. Scholarships may be awarded to residents of Pulaski County, Arkansas who are entering or continuing in any educational program in an institution certified by the State of Arkansas including colleges, universities, vocational schools and any other recognized post-high school program of study.

Goals of the scholarship are to provide financial assistance to students who may not be eligible for other scholarships. Consideration will be given to candidates demonstrating financial need, the motivation to achieve the highest level of self-improvement, and the potential for success in the field of study selected.

Applicants must complete the 2010 Altrusa Scholarship Application and essay and furnish written letters of recommendation, proof of prior educational experience, proof of acceptance into the intended program of study and proof of financial need.

A personal interview may be required as part of the application process. Scholarship recipients are expected to attend a general meeting of Altrusa International, Inc. of Little Rock, Arkansas to make a presentation to the Club about their use of the scholarship. The deadline for applications is January 15, 2010. Applications received by Altrusa after that date will not be accepted.
